ABOUT THE REGION

Hudiksvall is a city and the seat of Hudiksvall Municipality, in Hälsingland, Gävleborg County, Sweden with 15,015 inhabitants in 2010.

ABOUT THE HOSPITAL

Hudiksvall Hospital is an emergency hospital, which means that its operations at the radiology department are combined with both emergency and planned operations.

Right now, the hospital is further modernizing our business and preparing for new fresh premises. The number of employees: 16 radiographers, 13 Assistant Nurses, 6 ST doctors, four specialist doctors, 11 chief physicians, four administrators.



Main responsibilities and expectations

- The radiology department is part of the business area of Imaging and Functional Medicine. They work with diagnostic radiology with modern equipment.
- The clinic performs conventional X-ray examinations such as skeletons and lungs, sectional diagnostics with two computed tomographs and two magnetic cameras, X-rays / intervention and ultrasound examinations.
- Some treatment measures are also performed at the ward, such as narrowing of blood vessels and relief of the kidneys.

What's expected of you

- To be a radiographer.
- No clinical experience is required as the radiographer will be introduced for about 8-12 months, depending on previous experience. The introduction aims to learn the machinery, routines, methods and working methods on X-ray Hudiksvall.
- To be flexible.
- To have initiative and service-oriented.

Salary and Conditions

- The monthly salary as a radiographer without experience is at least 2,500 EUR.
- You will be working 50% while studying Swedish B2-C1 at 50%.
